All aspects of life are considered; our churches, our workplaces, our communities, and even ourselves and our families.



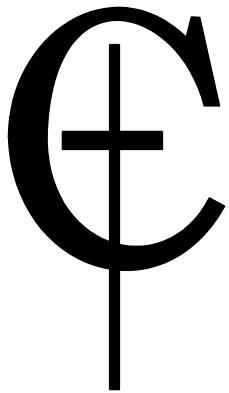
The Weekend Experience
