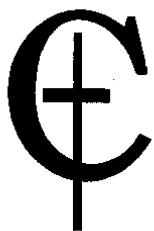


APPLICATION for a CURSILLO WEEKEND



What is Cursillo?

Cursillo is a movement of the Church that promotes Christian ideals, fellowship, and spiritual growth in daily living.

Yearly, a Cursillo weekend is held to introduce others to Cursillo and provide an experience to enable them to follow Jesus more faithfully and effectively.

What is a Cursillo weekend?

A Cursillo weekend is a personal, lively and informative event with talks, discussions, singing, worship and fellowship.

It provides an opportunity to deepen your Christian faith, and to experience the love of God within a supportive and prayerful community.

What is the cost of the weekend?

Much of the approximate \$225 (\$395/couple) cost is covered by those who have attended previous weekends. On the weekend, you are given an opportunity to make a tax deductible donation towards future attendance of others.

Finances should not dictate whether or not you attend a weekend. Talk to your sponsor about any concerns you have.

Who should go on a weekend?

A Cursillo weekend is **largely intended for** those who are:

- baptized, committed Christians
- active in their parishes
- interested in examining what it means to be a Christian in today's world

A Cursillo weekend is **also of value to** baptized Christians who:

- live as Christians, but are not presently involved in the Church
- have slipped away from the Church, but are beginning to move back

Experience over the years, has led to the following **recommendations**, which we ask you to consider:

- A person should wait at least a year before attending a Cursillo weekend, following major life events such as:
 - a Marriage Encounter weekend
 - change in marital status
 - serious illness
 - bereavement
- For married couples, it is desirable that both the partners attend Cursillo weekend.
- People with acute emotional problems or in psychiatric treatment should attend a weekend at a later time.
- For those with a physical handicap, check first with the registrar to determine what arrangements can be made to facilitate full participation.

Please get this report, along with the completed application form to the applicant's parish clergy by March 9, 2010, so the clergy will have time to fill in the clergy's report and get all 3 forms to the registrar by March 23, 2010.

Completed applications will be stamped with the date of arrival by the Registrar. The order of receipt is important. There is a limit to the overall number of participants, as well as numbers from each parish, the number of singles, and those whose spouses are not attending. Applying for the Cursillo does not confirm attendance on the Cursillo weekend. Applications will only be considered when all three forms have been received by the registrar.

Important Notes to the Sponsor on Applying for the Cursillo Weekend

This application consists of 3 parts:

1. The Applicant's form
2. The Sponsor's form
3. The Clergy's form.

The registrar must receive all 3 parts of the application before the applicant will be considered for the weekend.

There is a limit to the number of participants on the weekend. If there are more applicants than spaces, selection will be limited based on:

- Date of arrival of all 3 parts of the application
- Number of participants from each parish
- Number of single people
- Number of people whose spouse is not attending

Therefore applying for the Cursillo does not confirm attendance on the Cursillo weekend. The Registrar must receive applications by March 23, 2010. The Registrar will confirm acceptance to the weekend after March 23, 2010. When all three forms have been completed, please mail all three to the Registrar:

- Please get the Clergy's Report to the Applicant's Parish Clergy not later than March 9, 2010 so that he/she will have time to fill in the form and all three parts of the application can be sent to and received by the Registrar by March 23, 2010.
- Please take the responsibility to get the Clergy's report from him/her and send all 3 parts of the application to the Registrar or ensure that the clergy submits them.
